Served in a tall glass a delicious mix of cherry brandy, peach schnapps and orange juice

Banana liqueur, melon liqueur, grenadine and orange juice

## DRY/STRONG COCKTAIL

### Glass – €6.25

*If your tastes are more dry than sweet, if you prefer a Gin and Tonic to an Alco pop than these might be for you, be careful though, they are likely to knock your socks off. Unfortunately, due to the style of these drinks pitchers are not available*

#### 141 Dry Martini

Named after its inventor Martini de Anna de Toggia (interestingly enough not the vermouth), we offer it stirred, you wouldn't want us to bruise the gin now would you!

#### 142 Sweet Martini

Made with sweet red vermouth instead, otherwise known as the Martinez, this was the forerunner to the dry Martini

#### 143 Q Martini

Another one from the Bond saga, includes a dash of blue curacao

#### 144 Tequini

As the name suggests tequila replaces the gin

#### 145 Dirty Martini

Of course the martini needs its portion of vitamins so the humble olive is thrown in, with this recipe we include a dash of olive brine from the jar

#### 146 Blue Martini

Add a little lemon juice and blue curacao, shake like mad and watch the shimmer which comes off this cocktail

#### 147 Key Lime Martini

Add Cointreau and lime juice to the popular cocktail

#### 148 Tom Collins

During prohibition the awful "bathtub" gin needed to be jazzed up a bit, nowadays a quality gin makes it a pleasure to drink. Gin, lemon juice, sugar syrup and soda water

#### 149 Jack Collins

Tom has cousins from all over the world, his American cousin has JD

#### 150 Ivan Collins

Vodka from Russia

#### 151 Pedro Collins

Substitute white rum for gin

#### 152 Juan Collins

Tequila from Mexico

#### 153 Pierre Collins

Brandy from France

#### 154 Mac Collins

With Scotch

#### 155 Michael Collins

Irish whiskey

#### 156 Manhattan

The taste of the big apple with bourbon, sweet vermouth and just a touch of sweet and sour

This will have you flying up, up and away. Jameson, Pernod and soda

#### 165 Three Sun Rises

Jameson, cherry brandy and soda water

#### 166 Three Rivers

Whiskey, Dubonnet and Triple Sec

#### 167 Classic Cocktail

Triple Sec and cherry brandy with just a dash of lemon juice

#### 168 Sicilian Kiss

Amaretto and Southern Comfort over ice

#### 169 Sidecar

One of the classics, brandy, Triple Sec and lemon juice

#### 170 Between the sheets

As smooth as satin, with brandy, white rum and Triple Sec and a hint of lemon juice

#### 171 Whiskey Sour

A simple drink of whiskey, sweet and sour. Why not try substituting the whiskey for another spirit?

#### 172 Bourbon Sour

With Bourbon

#### 173 Polynesian Sour

With white rum and orange juice

#### 174 Old Fashioned

This cocktail even has a type of glass tumbler named after it. Bourbon, bitters and sugar

#### 175 Old Trout

A short drink with cCampari and orange juice

#### 176 White Lady

Elegant yet powerful - gin, Triple Sec and lemon juice

#### 177 Rickey

Gin, lime juice and soda water

#### 178 Blue Movie

Vodka, blue curacao, sweet and sour

Tequila, Crème de menthe and lime juice

**181 Pinata**

Tequila, Crème de bananes and lime juice

**182 Godfather**

This head of the family enjoys scotch whiskey with Amaretto over ice

**183 Godmother**

Replace the scotch with vodka

**184 Blue Arrow**

Gin, blue Ccuracao, lime cordial poured over crushed ice

**185 Gimlet**

A gimlet is a small sharp tool, bit like the drink, small and sharp. Gin, lime cordial and a twist of lime

**186 Rob Roy**

Drunk traditionally as a toast to any hero. Scotch, sweet vermouth, bitters and a twist of orange

**187 Whiskey Fix**

This drink is built in a short glass with scotch, sweet and sour over crushed ice

**188 Night Owl**

A lovely drink to be enjoyed early in the morning listening to mellow music. Bourbon, Triple Sec, lemon juice, bitters and soda water

**189 Skibbereen Tonic**

Whiskey and tonic with a twist of lemon

**190 Martha Washington**

Her husband fathered a nation, she invented this drink. Bourbon, cherry brandy and sweet and sour

**191 Cardinal**

Another cocktail invented in the famous Harry's Bar in Venice. This is like a Martini with a touch of Campari

**192 Bronx**

Each area of New York had it's own special drink during prohibition. This one is like a Martini but with a dash of orange juice

**193 Salvatore**

Vodka, cherry brandy, Cointreau and grapefruit juice

**194 Vodka Gimlet**

Like its gin equivalent, but with vodkas of course

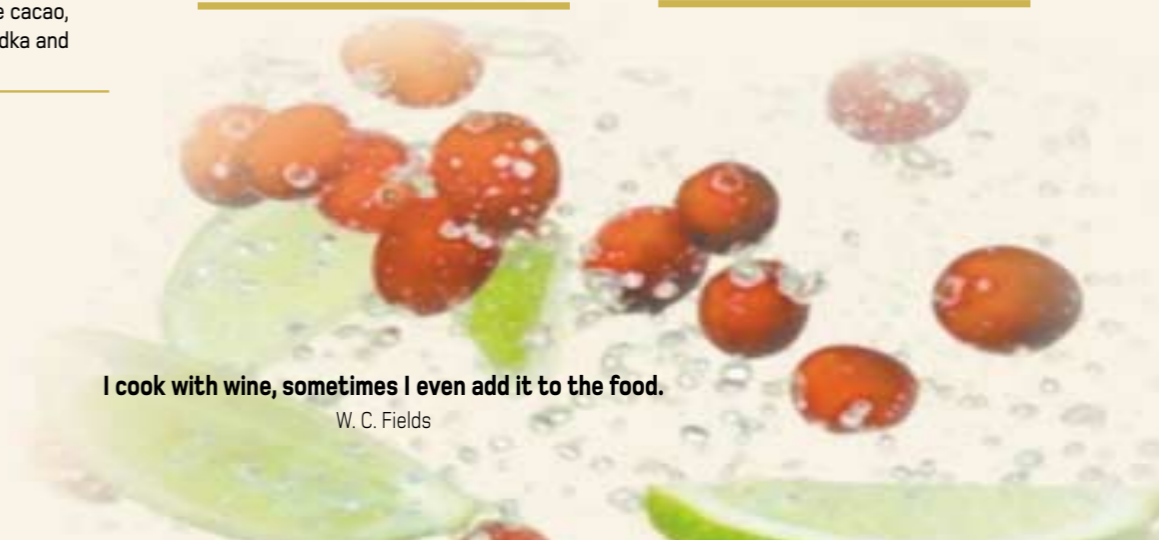
